



General Booking Terms – VOGUÉO

1. Scope of the Terms

These terms and conditions govern the booking procedures for the Lagoon 52 catamaran "Finisterre". They complement the official charter agreement (**Charter Party**) which will be signed by all parties in accordance with Greek maritime legislation.

2. Booking and Payment Conditions

- **Deposit:** A booking is confirmed only upon receipt of a **50%** deposit of the total charter fee.
- **Balance:** The remaining balance (**50%**) must be paid at least **30 days before** the embarkation date.
- **Payment Default:** Failure to pay the balance within the agreed timeframe will result in the cancellation of the booking. In this case, the deposit will be retained by the Owner as compensation.

3. Security Deposit

- **Amount and Purpose:** A security deposit of **€3,000** is required before embarkation. Although the presence of a professional skipper limits navigation-related risks, this deposit covers damages to the vessel, its interior fittings, or its dinghies/equipment resulting from the fault or negligence of the passengers.
- **Refund:** This amount is refunded within **15 days** after the end of the cruise, minus any costs for repairs, specialized cleaning, or missing equipment.

4. APA (Advance Provisioning Allowance)

- **Operation:** To cover variable costs during the cruise, an Advance Provisioning Allowance (**APA**) of **20%** of the charter fee is required when the balance is paid.
- **Covered Expenses:** The APA is used exclusively for fuel (engines and generator), port fees, marinas, local taxes, and provisioning (food and drinks).

- **Accounting:** The skipper maintains a precise record of expenses with receipts. Any remaining balance is refunded to the Charterer at the end of the stay, or the difference is billed if real expenses exceed the initial advance.

5. Cancellation Policy

- **More than 60 days before departure:** Full refund (excluding potential administrative fees).
- **Between 30 and 60 days before departure:** The 50% deposit is retained.
- **Less than 30 days before departure:** 100% of the total charter fee is due.

6. Skipper's Authority and Safety

The Skipper is solely responsible for safety on board. Their decisions regarding the itinerary and safety take precedence over any other consideration. A change of itinerary due to weather conditions does not entitle the Charterer to any compensation or refund.

7. Insurance and Liabilities

The vessel is fully insured; however, this insurance does not replace the passengers' personal liability or travel insurance. Damages caused by negligence (e.g., toilets blocked by prohibited items, cigarette burns) are the direct responsibility of the Charterer.
